UP NEXT...The Loyola Marymount women's basketball team remains at home this week to host Fresno State on Tuesday, Dec. 5 at 5 p.m. The game is the first of a doubleheader scheduled for Gersten Pavilion. The men's team welcomes Cal State Fullerton in the nightcap which will take place immediately following the women's game (approx. 7:05 p.m.).

LIONS OFF TO BEST START SINCE 1995-96...After splitting a pair of games at the Oakland Tribune Classic Loyola Marymount is off to its best start since the 1995-96 season - Head Coach Julie Wilhoit's first year in Westchester - when the Lions opened at 4-1. LMU has opened the 2000-01 season at 3-2 for just the fourth time in program history. More significantly, it is the first time Loyola Marymount has opened a season 3-2 while playing all Division I opponents.

REYNOLDS EARNS ALL-TOURNAMENT HONORS...Senior guard Taryn Reynolds was the only Lion to earn all-tournament honors at the Oakland Tribune Classic last weekend. Reynolds scored a team-leading 34 points and also dished out a team-leading nine assists on the weekend. She currently stands as LMU's leading scorer on the season as well, averaging 17.0 points per game for a total of 85 to start the season.

LIONS VS. FLORIDA INTERNATIONAL RECAP...The Loyola Marymount women's basketball team dropped a heartbreaking 63-67 loss to Florida International in the first game of the Oakland Tribune Classic hosted by California-Berkeley Saturday afternoon at Haas Pavilion. Senior guard Taryn Reynolds was the Lions' leader with 18 points on the day. The Lions went into the break at halftime down by just one point to FIU as the score stood at 29-28. The second half saw both the Lions and the Panthers battle for every basket as they were 11 lead changes in the final 20 minutes of play. LMU enjoyed a slim four-point lead with 9:31 remaining in the game as they pushed the score 48-44 as Lion sophomore forward Kate Murray made one of two free throws. Unfortunately for LMU, they saw the Panthers answer with eight straight points and FIU took a 52-48 lead with just under eight minutes remaining in regulation. The Lions tied the game 59-59 at the 2:13 mark but could not pull ahead as the Panthers went on to outscore LMU 8-4 in the final two minutes. For LMU, Reynolds was the team leader with 18 points, she also picked up three assists and two steals in the contest. Freshman Adrienne Slaughter followed with 13 points, six rebounds and two blocks. Forwards Murray and Bryn Britton each added 10 points, Britton also added in a team high seven boards, four assists and five steals.

LIONS VS. CAL STATE NORTHRIDGE RECAP...The Lions rolled to a 75-59 win over Cal State Northridge Sunday afternoon in the consolation game of the Oakland Tribune Classic. The Lions faced the Matadors in Haas Pavilion on the campus of California-Berkeley after falling to Florida International University in day one of the tournament on Saturday. Junior guard Bryn Britton recorded her first double-double of the year as she pulled down 10 rebounds while also posting a game-high 23 points. The Lions (3-2 Overall) went into the locker room at halftime down 30-31 despite being ahead through the first 19 minutes. Britton gave LMU its biggest lead of the half, 24-18, at the 8:20 mark draining a three-pointer off an assist from senior guard Taryn Reynolds. The Lions saw that lead slowly slip away as CSUN's ReShawna Richardson tied the game 27-27 with a field goal at the 3:08 mark. LMU regained the lead on free throws by sophomore center Shannon Wosman and Reynolds but the Matadors answered with back-to-back buckets to take a one-point advantage into the break. The Matadors (2-4 Overall) began the second half with a spark as they went on an 8-0 run and pushed the lead to 39-30 in the first two and a half minutes of play. The Lions quickly answered with a 9-0 run of their own to tie the game at 39-39. LMU would again tie the score at 41-41 before finally taking the lead again. Once in the lead the Lions never looked back as they enjoyed their largest lead of the game, 19 points (73-54), with just 1:38 remaining in regulation. For the Lions, Reynolds finished with 16 points, five boards and six assists while sophomore forward Kate Murray added in 14 points and eight rebounds. Rounding out LMU's double-digit scorers was Wosman who collected 13 points, nine rebounds and four assists. Kristi Rose led the Matadors' scoring effort with 18 points; she also posted a team-best eight rebounds in the game. Following Rose in the scoring drive was Myesha Saleem, Sha'Tasha Allen and Jenny Shetters, each of whom picked up eight points.

TARYN IT UP IN THE EARLY SEASON...Fifth-year senior guard Taryn Reynolds has been the unquestioned floor general for the Lions, and has proven her leadership by pacing the team with 17.0 points per game and 5.2 assists per contest. The Los Angeles, Calif., native has scored in double-digits in all five games this season, including a 21 point effort to open the 2000-01 campaign against San Diego State. With her early season spurt Reynolds has moved onto the LMU top-10 all-time scoring list with 821 points for her career. She already ranks fourth in school history with 170 steals and sixth all-time in assists at 226. Below is a list of LMU's top-10 all-time scoring list:

BANKING ON BRITTON...Junior guard Bryn Britton has been lighting it up from beyond the arc this season. The 5-11 native of Porterville, Calif. currently leads the Lions shooting .367 from three-point land converting 11 of her 30 attempts. She has improved her three-point career total to 58, a mark which ranks seventh on LMU's all-time list. Averaging 2.2 three-pointers a game at this point, Britton is on pace to smash the single-season school mark for three-pointers; that record was set by Meghan Kenny when she hit 48 during the 1997-98 season.

MAGNIFICENT MURRAY...Sophomore Kate Murray has picked up right where she left off after a fabulous freshman season last year. Murray, who averaged 7.2 points per game during her rookie campaign, has improved that average to 12.8 this season. The 6-foot-zero native of Tigard, Oreg. has provided the Lions with a much need scoring effort in the absence of guard Rosa Bernasconi. Murray recorded the first double-double of her collegiate career with a 23 point, 11 rebound effort against No. 23 Xavier two weeks ago.

INJURY REPORT...The Lions have been without the services of junior guard Rosa Bernasconi who has yet to see action this season due to injury. Bernasconi, a 1999-2000 All-WCC honoree, is currently rehabing a broken hand which she suffered during preseason practices, she is expected back within a week.

BULLDOG BITES...Fresno State hits the road for the first time this year, playing three games away from the friendly confines of the North Gym. The Bulldogs (2-2 Overall) went 1-1 in their two games last week, falling 52-57 to Northern Arizona but rebounding to sneak past Sacramento State with a 67-61 win. Lindsay Logan had a solid week scoring 31 points and adding 11 assists in the two games. She currently leads the FSU with 64 total points and a 16.0 point per game average. Omelogo Udeze ranks second in scoring among the Bulldogs, she is averaging 11.8 points per game and has tallied a total of 47 points on the year. Head coach Britt King is in her third year at the helm of the Fresno State women's basketball program. Including the 2000-01 record she has compiled a 21-39 mark in her three years with the Bulldogs. Fresno State leads the all-time series with LMU 1-0. The two teams last met Dec. 11, 1999, with FSU recording a 68-65 win over the Lions at the North Gym.

WILHOIT NAMED WCC COACH OF THE YEAR...Head Coach Julie Wilhoit captured the WCC Coach of the Year Award after guiding the Lions to their highest finish since 1990 last year. She is the first LMU women's basketball coach to earn the top coaching nod. Wilhoit is currently in her sixth season at the helm of the LMU women's basketball program. She was named the fourth head coach in the program's history on June 30, 1995. Wilhoit came to LMU after a two-year stint at the University of Pittsburgh-Bradford. With the Lions, she holds a 44-97 (.312) overall record and 17-59 (.239) record in West Coast Conference play. Wilhoit is in her 13th year as a head coach and owns a 164-167 (.495) overall record.
