Last Week

The 23rd-ranked LMU women's volleyball team enjoyed a week of rest after splitting its final two regular season conference matches two weeks ago. The Lions finished third in the West Coast Conference standings after falling at No. 15 Santa Clara, 1-3, and then defeating San Francisco 3-0 to round out the weekend. Senior outside hitter Sarah McFarland led the team with 70 kills on the weekend. She improved her season total to 751, one better than last year's mark of 750.

This Week

The Lions make plans to travel north for their sixth NCAA tournament appearance in seven years. For the second consecutive year, LMU will head up the coast to Santa Barbara, Calif. for the first and second round matches. The 14th-ranked UC Santa Barbara Gauchos play host to No. 22 LMU, No. 18 Stanford and Texas San Antonio in the Thunderdome. The No. 22 Lions and the No. 18 Stanford Cardinal begin the action on Thursday, Nov. 30 at 5:30 p.m., the UCSB and Texas San Antonio contest will immediately follow with a 30 minute break in between matches. Round two of the 2000 NCAA Volleyball Championships is set for Friday, Dec. 1 at 7:30 p.m.

There's Always Room For Improvement

Just when you thought senior outside hitter Sarah McFarland could not get any better...she does. The 6-6 Indiana native has one-upped herself posting 751 kills, one more than last year's mark of 750, and still has at least one more match to compete in. McFarland has now set a new LMU record with 2,009 career kills, a mark which ranks second in the West Coast Conference. McFarland will look to topple that mark of 2,028 set by Pepperdine's Nicole Sanderson from 1994-1997 this weekend when the Lions face No. 18 Stanford in round one of the NCAA tournament.

Brubacher Catches Fire In The Bay Area

Sophomore outside hitter Jaimie Brubacher added some punch to the Lions' offense in the Bay Area. Brubacher put up back-to-back double-doubles two weeks ago collecting 16 kills and 10 digs against Santa Clara and 16 kills, 13 digs against San Francisco. She currently ranks third on the squad with 196 kills on the season and is second among teammates with 225 digs.

Lions Among National And Conference Leaders

Despite competing in one of the toughest volleyball conferences in the country, Loyola Marymount continues to maintain steadfast in the upper tier of the WCC in almost every statistical category. As a team, the Lions lead the conference with 382 blocks and a 2.96 block per game average. LMU owns the top spot in the conference in service aces with a 1.45 per game average and second in hitting percentage (.268) and kills (1688). The Lions' 17.58 kill per game average is also among the nation's best ranking 13th in the country. Second only to Santa Clara among conference opponents with a 15.6 assist per game average, the Lions are 19th in the nation in that category.

Lions In The Rankings

LMU, ranked at No. 23 last week, moved up one spot in the USA Today/AVCA Division I Coaches Top 25 poll this week. The Lions are at No. 22 on the AVCA/USA Today chart following their Bay Area split two weeks ago. The Lions are receiving votes in the Volleyball Magazine Top 20 poll and come in at No. 25.

Oldtimer And Newcomer Earn Conference Honors

Senior outside hitter Sarah McFarland and freshman setter Nicole Oehlman were named to the 2000 All-West Coast Conference Team for their accomplishments throughout the season. McFarland, who has led the conference and the nation in kills all year, earned first-team accolades marking the third time in as many years that she has earned first-team honors. Oehlman, who garnered second-team honors, was the only freshman selected to either first or second teams.

The McFarland Watch

Senior outside hitter Sarah McFarland continues to top the NCAA statistical kills charts with 751 kills on the season. McFarland's efforts have earned her four WCC Player of the Week awards (Sept. 18, 25, Oct. 2, Nov. 6), an AVCA/Sports Import Division I National Player of the Week honor (Nov. 6) and was named WCC Player of the Month for her performance throughout the month of September. The 6-foot-6 native of Michigan City, Ind. was named a 2000 All-WCC first-team selection last week; she also currently leads the Lions defensively with 323 digs.

On The Brink Of Yet Another Record

Sarah McFarland has unofficially set a new NCAA single-season record with her 7.91 kills per game average. Contingent only on the 2000 season to officially end, McFarland will have smashed the old mark of 7.54 set by the University of Missouri-Kansas City's Catalina Suarez in 1988 when she collected 535 kills in 71 games. Currently McFarland's closest kills per game competitor is Houston's Jennifer Wittenburg who is averaging 6.26 kills per game.

Newsome Inching In On Single-Season Blocks Mark

Freshman middle blocker Tiana Newsome, who has already set a new freshman blocking record, is also climbing her way up the all-time single-season leaders board. She currently ranks second on that list with 128 blocks and is just seven blocks shy of owning the mark outright. Earlier this season, Newsome etched her name in the all-time match record book as well, (tie-3rd) when she collected 12 blocks against San Jose State on Sept. 1.

Lions Vs. Pac-10 Opponents

Drawing No. 18 Stanford in round one of the 2000 NCAA tournament could prove to be a blessing in disguise for the Lions. LMU is a perfect 4-0 in its last four meetings with Pacific-10 conference opponents with its most recent encounter coming in a 3-0 sweep of Arizona State (Sept. 2) earlier this season. It has been seven years since the Lions and the Cardinal met, their last battle (9/2/92) ended in a 0-3 home loss to Stanford at Gersten Pavilion.

Stratos Update

Head coach Steve Stratos is entering his eleventh year at the helm of the Loyola Marymount women's volleyball program. In 10 seasons at LMU, Stratos has led the Lions to eight 20-win seasons and eight postseason appearances, which includes six in the NCAA Championships (1994-97, 1999-00). Including the Lions record in 2000, Stratos has posted a career total of 232-100, for a .699 winning percentage, the highest in LMU volleyball history and among current WCC coaches. In West Coast Conference action, he owns a record of 118-36, for a .766 winning percentage. With 118 career conference victories, Stratos ranks second among current WCC coaches.

LMU at No. 15 Santa Clara (Nov. 17)

The 22nd-ranked Loyola Marymount women's volleyball team fell, 1-3, to No. 15 Santa Clara two weeks ago (18-16, 7-15, 12-15, 7-15). The match opened with an extended first game as both teams hit over .300. Santa Clara had five game points while leading 14-12, but could not convert the game-winner. The Broncos saw their sixth game point leading 15-14, but LMU was able to take the frame with a service ace by sophomore outside hitter Jaimee Brubacher. The Lions took an early 1-0 lead to open game two but the match stayed tight through a 5-5 tie. LMU was hindered by 19 service errors and eventually lost the game 7-15. LMU responded after the break to take a 5-1 lead before the Broncos called a time-out early in the third game. The Lions extended the lead to 7-1 before SCU climbed back to knot the score at 11-11. The Broncos never looked back at that point and went on to take a two games to one advantage over LMU. Down 9-2 in game four, the Lions returned from a time-out to score four straight points but it wasn't enough as SCU went on to take the game and match with a 7-15 win.

LMU at San Francisco (Nov. 18)

The Lions swept San Francisco 3-0 (15-13, 15-10, 15-12) in front of a crowd of 735 two weeks ago in USF's War Memorial Gym. The win marked head coach Steve Stratos' eighth 20-win season in ten years. All-American Sarah McFarland led the Lions with 31 kills, she was also one of five Lions who tallied double-digit digs with 13 on the night. Sophomore outside hitter Jaimee Brubacher also collected a double-double against the Lady Dons, she pounded out 16 kills and dug 13 balls. Outside hitters Laura Gustorf and Eleftheria Koukou and setter Nicole Oehlman were LMU's other dig leaders. Gustorf led the squad with her 16 digs while Oehlman and Koukou each picked up 10. Freshman middle blocker Tiana Newsome hit an eye-opening .455 against USF, she connected with 11 kills on 22 attacks while committing just one hitting error. Newsome's six blocks led the team and tied for a game-high.

Scouting No. 18 Stanford

The Stanford Cardinal are making their 20th appearance in the NCAA tournament. Stanford enters Thursday's contest after receiving an at-large bid with an 18-11 overall record and a 10-8 mark in Pac-10 play. Logan Tom leads the Cardinal with 273 kills on the year, she is trailed by teammate Tara Conrad who has tallied 262 kills this season. Lindsay Kagawa heads up Stanford's defense with 218 digs in 99 games played. The Cardinal are currently on a four-match winning streak in which they have lost just one of their last 13 games. Denise Corlett is in her 12th season at Stanford, her first as interim head coach. The Lions will be looking for their first ever win over the Cardinal this week. Stanford holds a 2-0 series advantage over LMU with the most recent encounter taking place on Sept. 2, 1992.

Scouting No. 14 UC Santa Barbara

Like Stanford, UC Santa Barbara has now earned a bid to all 20 championships. The Gauchos, who enter this year's tournament with a 23-7 overall record and a 14-2 mark in the Big West, match-up against Texas San Antonio in round one action. UCSB is looking to rebound from an 0-3 loss to No. 12 Brigham Young last week, that loss snapped the Gauchos eight-match winning streak their longest of the season. Danielle Bauer is topping the squad with 477 kills while Simone Kuhn and Erica Menzel follow closely with 379 and 317 kills, respectively. Brooke Rundle leads the UCSB defensive effort with 317 digs on the year. UCSB head coach Kathy Gregory has amassed a 622-270 career record in her 25 years with the Gauchos.

Scouting Texas San Antonio

The University of Texas San Antonio is making its initial appearance in the tournament field after winning the Southland Conference title which earned it an automatic qualification. The Roadrunners will have their hands full against No. 14 UC Santa Barbara whom they meet with a 24-8 overall record and a 17-3 conference mark. UTSA enjoys a balanced attack as five Roadrunners (Stacy Schmidt, Tamara Luckemeyer, Charlsie Heifrin, Katy Risinger, Natasha Biggers) have posted triple digit kill totals. Those same five, along with Nicole Camp, have also collected triple digit dig totals as well. UTSA is currently enjoying a 15-match winning streak in which it has won 45 of 52 games.
